We can quickly and accurately assess the issues presented.

We can explore the most appropriate options to resolve current difficulties.

We can facilitate conversations between clients and other individuals (co-workers or family members) to assist in resolving interpersonal difficulties.

We can provide health and well-being, as well as work-life balance seminars to support wellness initiatives.

We can tailor presentations for departments to address specific concerns.

We can debrief employees involved in critical incidents or traumatic events.

We can assist managers and supervisors through management consultations.

We can make referrals to community and University resources for specialized or on-going assistance.

Consultations are provided at no cost to clients and rendered in private office locations to ensure client comfort and privacy. Appointments and services are confidential to the fullest extent permitted by law. Management is not notified, and notations are not made in medical or personnel files.

The FSAP has offices on the Coral Gables and Miller School campuses. Each location is staffed by Florida licensed mental health professionals. Their expertise includes assessing a variety of issues. When necessary, they refer to appropriate resources.
